- 2. The motion to ratify the outcome of the December 9, 2010 Neighborhood Assembly on the liquor license for 2625 E 12th. Ave. was unanimously passed.

82 votes cast

22 of the 74 were in support of your application

52 of the 74 were in opposition to your application

7 of the 82 votes were outside E&L's designated area

3 of these 7 were in support of your application

4 of these 7 were in opposition to your application

1 of the 82 ballots was completed incorrectly and was not counted

- 4. Tom reported CPN's membership is up 10%.
