- A suggestion was made that Patrick might be a good person to head this up
- Follow Up: Becky will get in touch with Patrick to ask about his interest

### **Earth Day Festival Debrief**

#### **Survey Results**

- The survey went out to Green Team members and received 16 responses to date
- In general the responses were favorable with some good suggestions for improvements next year
- Discussion of venues
  - O There is a need to review locations for future events
  - O Consideration of costs, timing, location in neighborhood
- Thank you notes for the church and Joan
  - O Follow Up: send thank you notes; will sign at Green Team meeting on Saturday
- Documentation of volunteer hours
  - O <u>Follow Up:</u> check in with Girl Scouts to see if they need any documentation (Liz)
  - O <u>Follow Up:</u> next year have a volunteer sign-in sheet to track volunteer hours
- Suggestions for improvements
  - O Event app (such as Guidebook, which has a free option)
  - O Try and have everything in one place instead of separate rooms
  - O Improve outreach and communication about the event (location, parking, time)
  - O Involve youth groups more (Girl & Boy Scouts)

#### **Attendees**

- 46 slips turned in
- 28 attendees from Congress Park (remaining 40% from outside of Congress Park or did not identify their residence)
- 14 new sign-ups for the newsletter
- 3 new Green Team members signed up at event; 3 more have joined since
- 18 signatures of support for the Sustainable Neighborhood application
- 5 ideas submitted for projects or initiatives
- 200 estimated attendees!

## **Sustainable Neighborhood Application**

- Reviewed application requirements and suggested timeline for completing different components. Will share timeline with GT at Saturday meeting.
- Reviewed/discussed what other participating neighborhoods have posted on their websites, pulled together by Kimberly. Also requested to see their applications.
- Asset Maps
  - O Nam, Patrick, and Liz entered data from Earth Day
- Next Steps
  - O Application is due June 1
  - O Need volunteers to take on different parts of application
  - O Need to have the application done by May 25 (earlier? 21<sup>st</sup>?) so the CPN Board has time to review before application is submitted
- Outreach for Green Team meeting on Saturday
  - O Send notice to Next Door about meeting (Emily)
    - Need to get a Green Team id for Next Door
  - O Check about sending an email to CPN list (Liz)
- Survey

- O Ask for signatures of support for application (base on the application)
- o Include description of Sustainable Neighborhoods application
- O Structure around the categories used in SNN program
  - Ask for suggestions for projects (open-ended)
  - Ask for interest in previously suggested projects (check list)
- Lisa will take the lead in drafting survey and will share with Steering Committee for feedback
- o Goal is to get the survey distributed early next week and close the survey on 5/18
  - See about sending eblast to CPN
  - Send reminder on the 15th
  - How else should we post survey? CPN FB? Next-door post?
- o Sub-Committee will meet to tally results and review projects submitted
  - Sub-Committee: Lisa, Becky, Liz, Marilyn
  - Meet on 5/19 to review results

### Projects

- O Need to include all suggestions in the application but should prioritize the projects to work on first, based on greatest interest, other?
- O Becky will review the notes and will compile a list of projects suggested so far and put in the SNN categories
- At upcoming Green Team meeting (May 7), after presentation from Mikhaela Mullins from the SNN office, Green Team will be asked to come up with a list of suggested projects for application, and then (in small teams) will be invited to write proposals for specific projects.
  - Will have 1 week to put together project proposals
  - Liz will put together a template for people to use
