#### Future Projects:

- 1. CGD CPN Green Business Workshop & Proposals
  - Liz leading.
  - Will be held tomorrow, 2-3:30, afternoon at Cerebral Brewery it's open neighborhood wide event for any CPN business to learn about the Denver Green Business program.
    - Learning: Invite GT Members to attend as well in future event like this.
  - 35 businesses have RSVP'd so far wow!
    - Key was connecting with owner.
  - Will get credit for how many show up at tomorrow's event
  - A 2nd proposal is WIP, 2nd phase if GT member helps them do it, we would get credit! Will be a meeting on Thursday morning
  - It is possible for us to obtain a high number of credits as a result of the event and the 2nd proposal of GT helping businesses become green.
