**SCHEDULING ORDER**

**IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF BY THE WAY MANAGEMENT, INC., DOING BUSINESS AS MIDDLEMAN, FOR A TAVERN LIQUOR LICENSE AND A STANDARD CABARET LICENSE AT THE PREMISES KNOWN AND DESIGNATED AS 3401 EAST COLFAX AVENUE, DENVER COLORADO (BUSINESS FILE # 2017-0001165)**

On February 21, 2017, By The Way Management, Inc., doing business as Middleman, (the "Applicant") applied for a tavern liquor license and a standard cabaret license at 3401 E. Colfax Ave., Denver, Colorado.

As part of the licensing process, the Department scheduled a public hearing ("Hearing") on the application to be held on April 26, 2017. South City Park Neighborhood Association ("SCPNA"), a Registered Neighborhood Organization ("RNO"), did not receive notice of the Hearing as required.


On April 20, 2017, Terry Neyland, President of SCPNA, requested that the hearing date be reset to allow additional time for the RNO membership to consider and vote on the applications.

On April 24, 2017, Brian Proffitt, attorney for the Applicant, submitted Objections to the request for a continuance. Also on April 24, 2017, Terry Neyland submitted a response to the Objections.

The Department's consistent policy is to allow one continuance of a public hearing upon request for a party in interest or an RNO.

Therefore, the request to continue the Hearing is hereby GRANTED and a hearing shall be set for **May 25, 2017, at 9:00 a.m.**, at the Department of Excise and Licenses, 201 W. Colfax Avenue, Dept. 206, Denver, Colorado.
