USE INTERIOR AND EXTERIOR LIGHTING, INCLUDING TIMERS, TO MAKE YOUR HOME UNATTRACTIVE TO BURGLARS.

VISUAL DETERRENTS:

USE ALARMS, DECALS, SECURITY SIGNS, DOG WARNINGS, AND NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH STICKERS TO DETER BURGLARS.

TRIM IT UP:

TRIM YOUR TREES, BUSHES, WEEDS, ETC..ELIMINATE GOOD HIDING PLACES FOR BURGLARS. ENCOURAGE YOUR NEIGHBORS TO DO THE SAME.
