Ellen Forthammer gave a presentation on the 12th Avenue Bikeway. Funding approved in 2017 with the Elevate Denver Bond. 12th avenue is classified as a neighborhood bikeway. The area in Congress Park that would be affected is from 12th and Madison to 12th and Colorado Blvd. Ashley Grace, with DOTI, addressed some of the traffic concerns neighbors have around Teller Elementary.

Senator Chris Hansen introduced himself and gave an overview on his efforts regarding environmental issues statewide and gun safety issues. He reported there would be 3.2 billion dollars coming to Colorado and that school funding would be restored. and that PERA (Colorado Government retirement fund) is in better shape as well.

Councilperson Stacie Gilmore and her aide, Magen Elenz presented the proposed Rental Licensing ordinance, which will be before

City Council in a few weeks. Neighbors raised concerns about the impact this would have on housing stability and affordability.
