

#### Q1 Are you a resident of Congress Park Neighborhood





# Q2 Do you own your home or own property in Congress Park Neighborhood








# Q7 Looking up and down your street are many of the building similar in size, shape or design?



#### Q8 Has your street recently experienced scrapes?






# Q10 Are you concerned that your neighborhood may change significantly?

# Q11 What factors do you think could significantly change your neighborhood?








