NOTICE of PUBLIC MEETING

Jackson Street Storm Drain Project

Location: Carla Madison Recreation Center, 2401 E. Colfax Avenue, Denver **Meeting Date:** Wednesday, December 4, 2019 from 5:30-6:30 pm

Details: Denver Public works will be installing an improved, expanded storm drain system to provide greater flood protection for Congress Park residents, National Jewish Health (NJH) patients and staff, and local businesses from heavy rainstorms and other storm events. In addition, the new Jackson Street Storm Drain System will ultimately provide greater stormwater capacity for the upstream area around Hale Parkway.

Construction Location: Construction will start toward the end of 2019 or January 2020 at the intersection of E. Colfax Avenue and Jackson Street. The plan is to keep at least one lane of traffic open in each direction during this 3-4 month phase of construction. For the next 8-10 months, crews will install the storm pipe through National Jewish Health's parking lot to E. 14th Avenue and Jackson Street. Beginning in late 2020/early 2021, it is expected that storm pipe construction will then proceed east along E. 14th from Jackson Street for half a block toward Harrison Street. This segment should be completed in 3-4 months. New storm inlets will be added at E. 14th Avenue between Jackson and Harrison Streets. Full lane closures will be required on E. 14th Avenue



in the area around Jackson and Harrison Streets during the final phase of construction in early 2021. Access to residences and businesses will be maintained.
