You must also establish that the issuance of this license will not have an adverse effect on the health, welfare or morals of the neighborhood in question and that there is not good cause to deny the application. Please refer to the Hearing Policies and Procedures, as well as applicable state and local laws in order to properly understand your burden. You must present this evidence, even if the application is not contested.

Special Circumstances






