




#### Q5 Was your household included in the change to curbside trash pickup


#### Q6 Does your property have a 'Denver Hill' with steps to the street?


### Q7 Do you have a driveway to the street?


#### Q8 Have you experienced property damage because of city trash trucks?


## Q9 Do trash bins or pick up of large items interfere with your ability to park or safely walk?






