




#### Q5 Was your household included in the change to curbside trash pickup


#### Q6 Does your property have a 'Denver Hill' with steps to the street?


### Q7 Do you have a driveway to the street?






### Q10 Do you have trouble finding a place to put your bins or large items for pickup because of parked cars?






