







Q6 Does your property have a 'Denver Hill' with steps to the street?



Q7 Do you have a driveway to the street?




Q8 Have you experienced property damage because of city trash trucks?


Q9 Do trash bins or pick up of large items interfere with your ability to park or safely walk?




