

## Site Control Plan

The tap/sales room belongin to Cerebral Brewing will be controlled by physical barriers as well as employee oversight.

## Physical barriers.

The premise will be publicly accessible through two main entrances. One leading to the parking area and one to the communally accessible part of the Galaxie Building (common name of the three-tenant space that houses Cerebral Brewing.)

The Sales Room will be separated from production and employee-only areas by a set of double doors and surrounded by a 42" rail.

The patio will be accessible by two doors. The patio will be surrounded by a 42" high railing with the required closed emergency exit as the only aperture.

All exits from the premise will be marked with signage indicating that alcoholic beverages cannot be removed.

## Employee oversight.

All employees will be trained with a third-party alcohol serving and control body to ensure investigation of identification, prevention of sales to minors and the identification of intoxication and the prevention of over-service.

All exits are easily observed from the serving area and activity at those sites can be monitored both from the serving area as well as an individual making passes of the room.

Identification will be required for all patrons and will be requested by the server for each item ordered in a party.

Identification will be compared to an official photo guide as necessary. If an identification is deemed to be falsified or otherwise invalid, an attempt will be made to confiscate it and notify authorities.

An unique stamping procedure will be in place to assist in validating those individuals who have been determined to have a valid ID and are 21 or over. Provisions will be in place to bring extra employee oversight as necessary to verify ID at the requisite doors.
